Discussion

Board staff and board counsel with work on the letter to be sent to out to individuals who hold a salesperson license, but not a brokers, and who hold an instructors certificate. They will have six months to apply for the broker's license. If they do not obtain licensure in the six month window, they may petition the board for an exemption from the approved instructor regulation requirements, for which the board will make such a determination. May continue teaching during this timeframe. A motion was made by Linda Kody and seconded by Peter Ruffini:

To issue letter that gives the individuals who only hold a salesperson license 180 days to become licensed as a broker. If they do not, they may need to come petition the board.
