DECISION

PEPPER DINING, INC. D/B/A CHILI'S GRILL AND BAR 70 WALKERS BROOK DRIVE READING, MA 01867

Pepper Dining, Inc. d/b/a Chili's Grill and Bar ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, November 14, 2023, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Bolcome and Anderson's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Wednesday, May 17, 2023, at approximately 6:52 p.m., Investigators Bolcome and Anderson ("Investigators") conducted a compliance check at Pepper Dining, Inc. d/b/a Chili's Grill and Bar.
- 2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, one Bud Light beer, for six dollars (\$6.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2007 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING.**
