NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws c. 13, s. 92; c. 112, ss. 61, 175, 178, 179, and 180; and c. 30A, the Board of Real Estate Appraisers will hold a public hearing regarding proposed amendments to its regulations at 264 CMR 5.00. The proposed amendments to these regulations adopt revisions of federal criteria for the education and experience required for each type of appraiser license, and they amend the standards for obtaining and recording work experience hours required for each license. The hearing will be held at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, January 16, 2020 at the Division of Professional Licensure at 1000 Washington Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02118-6100. Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present testimony orally or in writing at the hearing.
