




RECERTIFICATION

Individuals employed as a law enforcement officer in Massachusetts on July 1, 2021 were certified by statute and will be recertified based on last name. Each certification is valid for three years.

Officers with last names A-H were recertified July 1, 2022. Officers with last names I-P will be recertified July 1, 2023. Officers with last names Q-Z will be recertified July 1, 2024.

2023 eligibility: I-P officers employed by a law enforcement agency who were working in a police capacity on July 1, 2021 and have not been newly certified or previously issued a certification number, including full-time, part-time, reserve officers, officers on leave, and retired officers that work details.



Departments will receive a login to the new online recertification portal in May for document submissions for officers I-P who have not already been issued a certification number.

Attestation form is not required for those being attested to. For those not attested to, see instructions in online portal.

Officers on extended leave who have not met recertification requirements are classified as "not certified" and tracked as "on leave" until they return to full duty.
