

Covered Agreement Reciprocal Jurisdictions

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 175, §20A and 211 CMR 130.08, non-U.S. jurisdictions that are subject to an in-force covered agreement with the United States, each within its legal authority, or, in the case of a covered agreement between the United States and European Union, is a member state of the European Union, shall be recognized as a reciprocal jurisdiction. On September 22, 2017, the United States and the European Union signed the *Bilateral Agreement Between the United States of America and the European Union on Prudential Measures Regarding Insurance and Reinsurance*, which has entered into force. On December 11, 2018, the United States and the United Kingdom signed the *Bilateral Agreement between the United States of America and the United Kingdom on Prudential Measures Regarding Insurance and Reinsurance*.
