Summary of Decision

Doctor who failed to report on his license renewal application that he had been charged with Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol is subject to discipline by the Board.

RECOMMENDED DECISION


On September 15, 2015, the Board of Registration in Medicine issued a Statement of Allegations ordering William E. O'Connor, Jr., M.D. to show cause why he should not be disciplined for failing to report in his 2007 license renewal application that he had been charged in 2006 with Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On October 30, 2015, by mutual agreement among the parties, Complaint Counsel filed a Stipulation of Facts and Conclusions of Law. The stipulation is signed by Dr. O'Connor and Complaint Counsel. The Stipulation is attached as Exhibit 1.

Other than the Stipulation and the admissions of fact it contains, I have not taken evidence with respect to the facts of this matter. I adopt the facts as stipulated. The conclusions of law set forth in the Stipulation are warranted and I therefore adopt them as well.

Based on the foregoing, I recommend that the Board impose such discipline on Dr. O'Connor as it deems appropriate in light of the facts and conclusions of law as stipulated by the parties.
