WHAT IS WORKPLACE FRAUD?



Time fraud: getting paid for hours not worked.



Larceny: selling or using publicly owned equipment for your own benefit.



Kickbacks: awarding a contract to a vendor in exchange for payment.



Billing fraud: submitting false invoices or expense reports.

RED FLAGS

Living beyond means: vacations, jewelry, cars, clothes. Sudden financial pressure: divorce, illness, job loss.

- Unusally close relationship with vendor/customer.
- Control issues: unwilling to share duties, go on vacation.
- Defensive when questioned.
- Resistant to new controls.
