Background: The Unemployment Insurance (UI) program provides an important core service in the comprehensive, integrated workforce system established under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). Through the UI program, individuals who have lost employment through no fault of their own and have earned sufficient wage credits may receive UI benefits if they meet initial and continued UI eligibility requirements. DCS and DUA have been striving to address individual reemployment needs of UI claimants, and to prevent and detect UI improper payments through the UI RESEA program since 2005. Both activities are high priorities for the Department's Employment and Training Administration (ETA).

The RESEA program has provided claimants entry to a full array of reemployment services available at American Job Centers (AJC's), and has helped to ensure that claimants comply with all UI eligibility requirements. Individuals filing UI claims are active job seekers who, through the states RESEA program are made aware of the variety of reemployment services that are available to them. They are referred to the appropriate reemployment service for their individual needs.

*Seating is limited to **25 participants** and assigned on a first-come first-serve basis. Due to limited space, we ask that each career center schedule only a supervisor or the L.O.E. to attend. <u>Early registration is recommended.</u>
