**MEMORANDUM AND ORDER ON LICENSEE'S**  
**REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION OF**  
**INDEFINITE SUSPENSION**

**HILLSIDE COUNTRY CLUB BY LOMBARDI'S, INC. DBA HILLSIDE COUNTRY CLUB**

Hillside Country Club By Lombardi's, Inc. dba Hillside Country Club (the "Licensee") holds an all alcoholic beverages club license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Thursday, January 17, 2013, regarding alleged violations of M.G.L. c. 151A, §14 and §15.

By decision dated January 17, 2013, the Commission found the licensee violated the above-referenced charges and **INDEFINITELY SUSPENDED** the license of Hillside Country Club by Lombardi's, Inc. dba Hillside Country Club **effective forthwith**, until further written order of the Commission.

The Commission stated that it would consider issuing a further order upon written request of the Licensee showing good cause to reconsider this indefinite suspension and a hearing before the Commission that the licensee attends.

The Licensee filed a written request to reconsider the indefinite suspension. The Licensee attended a hearing before the Commission on Tuesday, November 5, 2013, and argued that good cause exists to reconsider the indefinite suspension.

At this hearing, the following documents were admitted in evidence:

1. Department of Unemployment Assistance Release dated October 7, 2013;
2. Department of Revenue Release dated October 11, 2013;
3. State of Rhode Island Superior Court Order dated April 9, 2013, Appointing Permanent Receiver;
4. Commonwealth of Massachusetts Suffolk County Superior Court Order dated March 27, 2013, Appointing Temporary Receiver;
5. State of Rhode Island Superior Court Amended Order dated March 15, 2013, Appointing Temporary Receiver;
6. Commission Notice of Suspension dated January 17, 2013;
7. Letter from M & S Service Bureau dated July 31, 2013, Stating Licensee Not Posted on the Credit Delinquency List.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing. The Commission took administrative notice of the Commission records regarding this Licensee.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence presented at the hearing, the Commission reconsiders and reverses its prior order of **INDEFINITE SUSPENSION** of the license of Hillside Country Club by Lombardi's, Inc. dba Hillside Country Club **effective forthwith**.

The indefinite suspension is reconsidered and reversed to a suspension of time served from January 17, 2013 to October 5, 2013.
