


MassDOT is currently at 50% capacity with salt with deliveries beginning in October. Plan to be at 80% by the end of October and 90% by the end of November



# Construction Update: Braintree Superstructure Replacement


- Project finished at 11:30pm on Sunday, September 24<sup>th</sup>, 6.5 hours ahead of planned 5am Monday opening time.
