### Next steps

**Complete all 3 steps to continue receiving your unemployment benefits:**

1. **Log in or create a JobQuest account** at [mass.gov/jobquest](https://mass.gov/jobquest).
2. **Before [DATE]**, complete a Career Center Seminar (CCS) online or in person. Log into JobQuest to find a CCS that works for your schedule, or call (800) 653-5586.
3. **Before [DATE]**, attend two meetings with MassHire Career Center staff virtually or in person. Staff will help you schedule these meetings after you complete the CCS.

**Already back to work full-time?** Let Career Center staff know as soon as possible. If you do not, future unemployment claims may be impacted. Find a Career Center near you at [mass.gov/FindACareerCenter](https://mass.gov/FindACareerCenter).

### How else can the Career Center help me?
