Welcome to the Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA). The RESEA Road Map provides an overview of the steps you must complete within the RESEA program. Note: The **deadline dates in your letter** must be met to avoid any sanctions related to your unemployment benefits.



Receive your letter

Your letter will provide the RESEA requirements **and** **deadline dates** for completing. Keep these for reference!

Career Center Seminar (CCS)

Schedule and attend a Career Center Seminar with your local Career Center or complete the on-demand version on MassHire Jobquest.

You will meet and review your RESEA requirements with a Career Counselor and discuss your employment goals.
