5. I understand that my resignation is a disciplinary action that is reportable to any national data-reporting agency, pursuant to G.L. c. 112, §2.

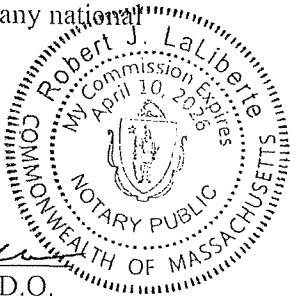
