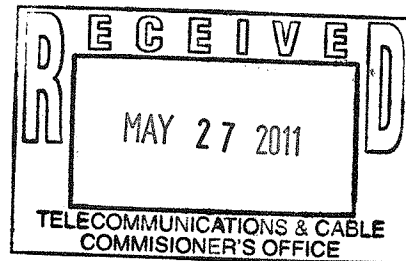

Per the franchise agreement with Southborough:

7.2.1 PEG Access Capital Funding: The Licensee shall provide equipment and/or facilities funding to the Issuing Authority and/or the Access Provider, as directed to the Licensee by the Issuing Authority in writing in this Renewal License for the support of the production of local PEG Access Programming and/or other cable-related purposes (the “PEG Access Capital Funding”). The PEG Access Capital Funding provided by the Licensee hereunder shall be Eighty Three Thousand and Three Hundred Dollars (\$83,300), payable as follows:

- \$13,300 within ninety (90) days of the Effective Date;
- \$15,000 on or before the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) anniversary of the Effective Date;
- \$15,000 on or before the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) anniversary of the Effective Date;
- \$10,000 on or before the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) anniversary of the Effective Date;
- \$10,000 on or before the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) anniversary of the Effective Date;
- \$10,000 on or before the sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) anniversary of the Effective Date; and
- \$10,000 on or before the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) anniversary of the Effective Date.

The Town and/or the Access Provider shall own all equipment purchased with funding pursuant to this Section 7.2.1, and the Licensee shall have no obligation to maintain, repair, replace or insure any such equipment.
