Dear Restorative Justice Practitioner,

We are reaching out to you in fulfillment of our mission as the Restorative Justice Advisory Committee (RJAC) established by <u>Section 202 of Chapter 69 of the Acts of 2018</u>.

The RJAC is committed to the promotion of restorative justice options and alternatives for adult and juvenile diversion within the Commonwealth and the broader development of restorative justice practices across the state. Our committee is composed of restorative justice advocates appointed by the governor and representatives of public safety agencies. Members of the public are invited to all RJAC meetings. Meetings are held the second Tuesday of every month from 11:00am to 1:00pm. Currently, the meetings are held virtually and the agenda is posted 48 hours in advance. To join the meeting virtually and access the agenda, please visit our website under Upcoming Events.

The purpose of this <u>survey</u> is to begin to build an inventory of the existing restorative justice activity and capacity within the Commonwealth. *We want to learn about the work of your organization in order to develop better ways to support the growth of restorative justice in our state.* This is our first step in building the knowledge that will help map the available and still needed resources for restorative justice in Massachusetts.

We hope to create ways for programs, practitioners, community and systems to grow together and work together. This survey process is not simply a mechanism to serve systems, our hope is to begin process that connects programs and solo community practitioners across Massachusetts. Although we have a statutory mandate to connect to programming that is interested in working with the criminal justice system, we recognize and understand the work is much broader than system engagement and hope to create a process that connects practitioners and communities to each other.

We kindly ask that you fill out the survey and provide us additional names/contact information of individuals and organizations that are working to develop restorative justice practice within the Commonwealth. We are very grateful for your time and attention and we urge you to join us at the RJAC meetings to add your voice to the coalition of committed citizens here in Massachusetts.
