<sup>1</sup>These counts reflect inmates on RH status in a Restrictive Housing Unit (RHU) and excludes inmates in a RHU who are not on RH status.

<sup>2</sup>This count includes inmates temporarily housed in a quarantine unit while on Restrictive Housing status; the Department of Correction implemented quarantine units due to the COVID-19 pandemic. For the purposes of this report, inmates on RH status but temporarily housed in a Health Services Unit or Quarantine Unit are counted in the only RHU for this facility, thus appearing more than operational capacity.

As part of the Department’s continuous quality improvement process, the Department assesses past and present reports to ensure that accurate data has been and continues to be reported. As a result of this process, the Department is providing updated data to reflect the fact that during the reporting period, the Department did not house inmates diagnosed with an SMI in restrictive housing conditions in the DDU.
