³The Department no longer utilizes restrictive housing at these facilities and, as of May 18, 2022 at SBCC and April 4, 2022 at the other facilities, transitioned to a Behavior Assessment Unit (BAU) model of intervention. While in a BAU, inmates are not housed in restrictive housing, as defined by G.L. c. 127, sec. 1, the American Correctional Association, or 103 CMR 423.
