³With the dissolving of the DDU on June 16, 2023, the Department no longer utilizes restrictive housing at any facility. As of May 18, 2022 at SBCC and April 4, 2022 at the other facilities housing males, the Department transitioned from use of restrictive housing to a BAU model of intervention. As detailed above, MCI-Framingham ceased using restrictive housing on March 12, 2020.
