NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

After a hearing on May 9, 2012, the Commission finds Enterprise Liquor Store, Inc. dba Woody's Liquors in violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: c.138, §34.

The Commission suspends the licensee's license for a total of six (6) days. The suspension shall commence on Wednesday, June 27, 2012 and terminate on Monday, July 2, 2012. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, June 27, 2012 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Tuesday, July 3, 2012.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

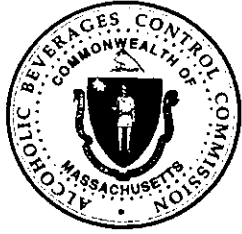

Enterprise Liquor Store, Inc. dba Woody's Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an all-alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Wednesday, May 9, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of: 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Capurso's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Capurso's Compliance Check Field Report dated March 13, 2012; and
2. The Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On Tuesday, March 13, 2012 at approximately 07:48 p.m., Investigators Brad Doyle and Paul Capurso conducted an investigation of the business operation of Enterprise Liquor Store, Inc. dba Woody's Liquors.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-two ounce (22 oz.) bottle of Sam Adams beer, for three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.




CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated: 204 CMR 2.05 (2) to wit: Ch.138, §34. Therefore the Commission **suspends the license for six (6) days, of which three (3) days will be served, and three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years, provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**

**By decision dated February 14, 2012, the Commission had previously ordered a three (3) day license suspension, but had held the suspension in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations occurred. Based on the violation found above, the licensee violated the conditions of that three (3) day suspension being held in abeyance. The Commission hereby orders that suspension to be served on and after the three (3) day suspension. The licensee will serve a total six (6) days.**


