Ocean Liquors Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 4, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Michael Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report.

2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

FACTS


1. On, July 6, 2011 at approximately 6:59 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Ocean Liquors Inc.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a forty (40) ounce Coors Light for three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. Administrative review of the file indicates the licensee has not had a violation in ten (10) years.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
