RE: Notice of Facility Closing

Dear Mr. Antoine Jones,

In accordance with Mass. Gen. Laws Ann. Ch. 149 § 179B; Ch. 151A § 71B, we are writing to inform you that Revvity, Inc. will be permanently closing its facility located at 549 Albany Street, Boston, MA 02118, which affects all personnel and operations at the site for Revvity, Inc., and all its applicable subsidiaries at the site, including Revvity Health Sciences, Inc.

While the majority of employee separations are scheduled to begin around April 2026, please be advised that an initial phase of layoffs may occur as early as sixty (60) days from the date of employee notification (i.e., November 2025), depending on business needs. All separations related to this closure are expected to be completed by December 2026.

All positions and jobs at the facility will be eliminated, and approximately seventy-four (74) employees will be affected. Please be advised that while the majority of separations will occur within the dates noted above, two employees are expected to be retained beyond December 2026, with the last exit anticipated to be by August 2028. This extended employment is necessary to oversee specific site decommissioning activities, including the management and disposal of radioactive materials in compliance with regulatory permitting requirements.

Employees at this facility are not represented by a union and there are no bumping rights. All affected employees will receive at least 60 days' written notice of their position elimination and separation date.


