RE: Amended WARN Notice of Facility Closing

Dear Mr. Antoine Jones,

We are writing to provide you with an amended notice regarding the permanent closure of Revvity, Inc.'s facility located at 549 Albany Street, Boston, MA 02118. This letter serves as an amendment to the original notice you received from us dated September 10, 2025.

First, the original notice stated that approximately seventy-four (74) employees would be affected. We have since determined the correct number of affected employees is seventy-six (76). This revision accounts for positions inadvertently omitted from the original list provided to you; however, such employees did receive their individual WARN notices from the company.

Second, we wish to inform you that the company is offering a number of these employees the opportunity to transfer to our facility in Hopkinton, MA. We are providing this notice to all seventy-six (76) employees out of an abundance of caution. While a transfer to a location within a reasonable commuting distance may not constitute an "employment loss" under the federal WARN Act, we believe it is important that all affected employees and state officials are fully informed of this process.

As stated previously, all on-site positions at the Boston facility will be eliminated according to the timeline provided. The affected employees are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement, and bumping rights are not available. The complete and updated list of all seventy-six (76) job titles and affected employees is provided below:


