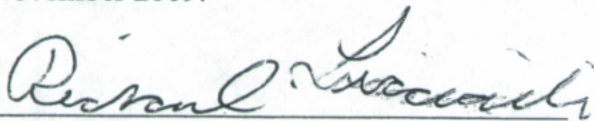
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VOLUNTARY SURRENDER STATEMENT

I, Richard Licciardi (Reg. No. 10376), do voluntarily surrender my registration as a pharmacy technician in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to the Board of Registration in Pharmacy (Board) and do state to the Board:

1. I hereby voluntarily surrender my registration as a pharmacy technician in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (Reg. No. 10376) together with any right to renew my registration, to the Board, effective as of the date of my signature hereto;
2. I acknowledge and agree that I have surrendered my pharmacy technician registration to the Board in resolution of Complaint Docket No. PHA 2009-0182 (Complaint);
3. I understand that surrender of my registration is considered to be a reportable disciplinary act which deprives me of all privileges of registration; that my surrender is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review; and that I am waiving my right to a hearing pursuant to G.L. c. 30A regarding the Complaint;
4. I will surrender any current pharmacy technician registration issued by any other jurisdiction effective as of the date of my signature hereto and will not apply or attempt to gain registration as a pharmacy technician or to renew any pharmacy technician registration previously issued by any other jurisdiction prior to entering into an agreement with the Board in resolution of the Complaint; and
5. I acknowledge that I have been provided the opportunity to consult legal counsel regarding my decision to execute this statement and surrender my registration and that my decision to execute this statement and surrender my pharmacy technician registration was made of my own free will.
