## A. Requirements and Instructions

This application is for Active Duty U.S. Military Personnel Only per Chapter 460 of the Acts of 2010.
Applicant must demonstrate receipt of the award and current status of being on active military duty in the U.S Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, or Coast Guard (including National Guard or Reserve on active duty) at the time of application.
Mailing Instructions: Active Duty Awarded Medal Plates are not available in RMV Service Centers.

- Complete and sign this application
- Mail this completed application and the required documentation below to the address above.
- A legible photocopy of your current vehicle registration
- A legible photocopy of your Military ID Card (and a document to satisfy your "active duty" status if not on the Card)
- A legible photocopy of the document awarding you the specific medal
- Complete Registration and Title Application (RTA) including insurance company stamp

The Special Plates Department will mail the plates to the address in the RMV's current registration record. Please allow 7-10 days for manufacture and mailing.
B. Applicant Information (must be the owner, co-owner, or lessee of the vehicle to which the plate will be attached)


## D. Awarded Medal Plate Choice

I am applying for the designated registration plate I have checked below based on my receipt of an awarded medal represented by the plate. I understand that I am entitled to one set of plates for each medal awarded and that I can choose a Passenger or Motorcycle registration, as appropriate for my registered vehicle. I also understand that I must provide additional documentation of a separate awarded medal if I seek an additional set of Awarded Medal Plates for another vehicle.Silver Star Plate: Issued to active duty military personnel who have been awarded the Silver Star Medal (not silver campaign, battle, or service stars). No fee.Bronze Star Plate: Issued to active duty military personnel who have been awarded the Bronze Star Medal (not bronze campaign, battle, or service stars). No fee.Distinguished Flying Cross Plate: Issued to active duty military personnel who have received the Distinguished Flying Cross. No fee.Purple Heart Plate: Issued to active duty military personnel who have been awarded the Purple Heart Medal. No fee.

## E. Signature

The RMV reserves the right to contact, at any time, the U.S. Department of Defense and/or the appropriate branch of the U.S. military service (or National Guard or Reserve, if on active duty) in which you claim active duty status to verify that status and receipt of the indicated award. If your claim to active duty status and/or receipt of the indicated awarded medal cannot be verified, the Registrar may refuse to issue the plate, may revoke an issued plate, and may refer the matter to proper authorities for investigation.
I hereby certify, under the penalties of perjury:

(iii) that I agree to cooperate with the RMV if additional information about my active duty status or receipt of the award is needed by the RMV, and;
(iv) that I understand and agree that the Active Duty Awarded Medal Plate is intended for active duty military personnel only and I further agree to turn in the plate to the RMV upon leaving active military service and understand that I may apply for a similar Awarded Medal Veteran's Plate (if qualified), also for no fee, at that time.
