REAL ID Countdown

REAL ID compliance is May 7, 2025

- Every air traveler 18 years of age and older will need a REAL ID compliant driver's license or identification card, or another TSA-acceptable form of identification, for domestic air travel and to enter certain federal facilities.

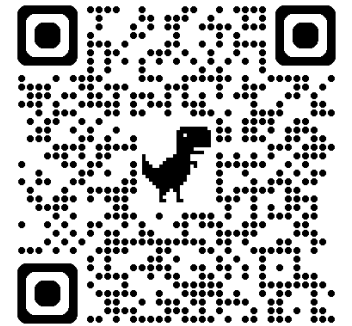

On May 7, 2025, U.S. travelers must be [REAL ID](https://www.mass.gov/id) compliant to board domestic flights and access certain federal facilities.



International Registration Plan (IRP) Renewals

4

- IRP = a registration agreement among US states, the District of Columbia, and Canada. IRP is a program for registering commercial vehicles traveling in 2 or more IRP jurisdictions.
- Fees are determined based on miles traveled and vehicle weight.
- The USDOT # is verified with FMCSA to determine if there are any Federal Out-of-Service orders which can result in suspension of registration.
- IRP registrations must be renewed each year by 6/30. Renewal packets were mailed out on 04/01/2024 with instructions to renew online via a portal or by mail.

Vulnerable User – Update

RMS vendors and Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) adoption

- **10** of 12 RMS vendors have gone live with the new crash report form.
- **322** of 352 (**91%**) LEAs have updated their software and started to use the new crash report form.

Vulnerable User Data

- **68** towns have reported crashes with Vulnerable Users using the new form.
- **357** Vulnerable Users involved:
 - 239 Pedestrians
 - 70 Bicyclists
 - 18 Motorized scooter riders
 - 4 Motorized Bicyclists
 - 4 Electric Personal Assistive Mobility device
 - 2 Non-Motorized Scooter Riders
 - 2 Other Micromobility Device user
 - 1 Tricyclist
 - 1 Non-Motorized Wheelchair User
 - 1 Skateboarder

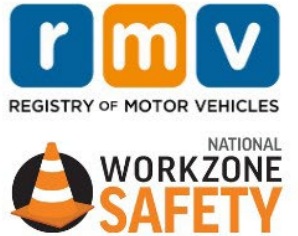
