Three or more surchargeable events within a two-year period requires completion of an 8-hour Massachusetts Driver Retraining Course.

In CY2023:

- Of the more than 4.9 million licensed drivers in Massachusetts, less than 1% (28,831 drivers) were required to complete the Driver Retraining Program.
 - Of those, approximately 72% were required to take the program one time
 - 19% of the drivers have two requirements
 - less than 9% of these drivers accumulated enough violations on their driving record to warrant three or more requirements
- For CY2023, 1,335 Junior Operators were required to take the driver retraining course and 1,564 Junior Operators were required to take the State Courts Against Road Rage course



REAL ID TSA Proposed Rulemaking issued 9/12/24

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) published a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that would provide federal agencies with necessary flexibility to begin enforcement of the REAL ID regulations on the May 7, 2025, deadline in a manner that takes into account security, operational risk and public impact.

- This does NOT change the compliance date- May 7, 2025
- Apply for a REAL ID if you think you need a compliant government issued credential



55% of credential holders in Massachusetts have a REAL ID.
