- 282 plates awarded to winners who will have until December 31st to claim their plate

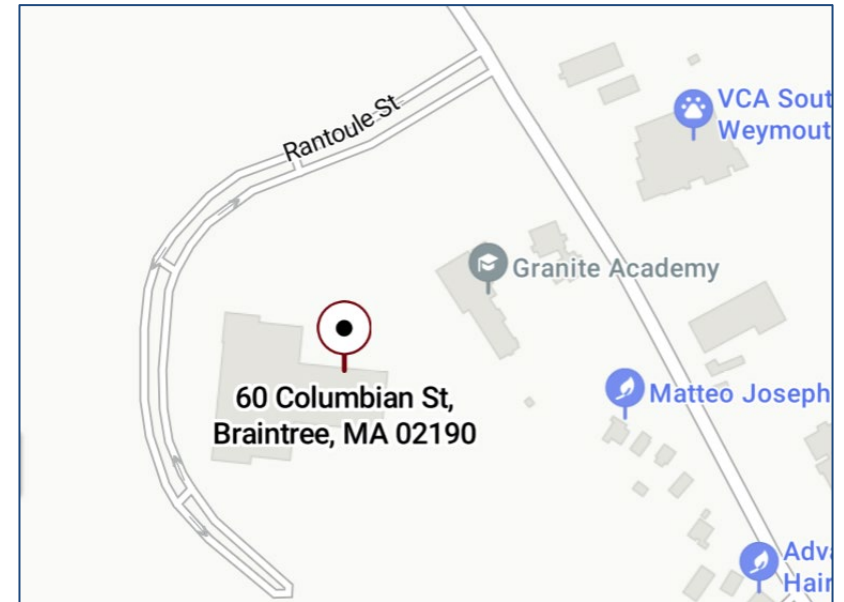
RMV Service Center Change

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Braintree RMV – new location

Braintree RMV will move from 10 Plain Street, Braintree to 60 Columbian Street, Braintree on September 22nd.

Program Updates

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Vehicle Inspection Equipment Upgrade – OPUS

- Replace and calibrate new equipment at 1,768 inspection stations (1,856 workstations)
- Opus has added five more resources to MA team to assist with the hardware install schedule. Schedule has extended into October.
- Opus has completed 1,043 workstation installs (56% of all workstation installs) as of August 15th



Workstation Equipment Upgrade – IDEMIA

- Replace workstations in all Service Centers and AAA locations including peripheral equipment – 334 workstations
- Installs will be done off-hours during the week and on weekends
- Installs began in August and expect to complete in December 2025

FMCSA Annual Commercial Program Review

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Each state's commercial drivers license program is subject to annual review by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration

- Performance review kicked off August 19th
- Detailed checklist of regulatory compliance
- Onsite visit to Service Center and to commercial skills testing site
- 5 findings from last year
- 3 Legislative findings have been resolved with legislative enactment in August 2025
