



## **Automatic Voter Registration (AVR)**

- RMV removed the 'opt out' option in 2023 as part of VOTES Act
- All eligible MA residents are registered to vote as part of a permit, license, or ID transaction (including renewals)

#### **Process**

- RMV transmits data daily to Secretary of the Commonwealth (SoC) for eligible MA residents to register to vote
- 2. SoC provides data to cities/towns
- 3. Cities/towns send MA resident information about their voting status

## **Low Number Plate Lottery**

- The Low Number Plate Lottery was held on September 10.
- 18,616 vehicle owner submissions
- 298 winners and 25 alternates were selected
- Winners will have until December 31 to claim their plate.
- Winners are posted on Mass.Gov/RMV

Massachusetts10302024 Low Plate Lottery










#### **REALID**

- Targeted messaging to Standard card holders
