Program Updates



Vehicle Inspection Equipment Upgrade – OPUS

- Replace and calibrate new equipment at 1,758 inspection stations (1,838 workstations)
- Opus has completed all workstation installs that are being utilized
- 46 stations still need new cameras to be installed by station owners



Workstation Equipment Upgrade – IDEMIA

- Replace workstations in all Service Centers and AAA locations including peripheral equipment – 347 workstations
- Installs will be done off-hours during the week and on weekends
- As of November 19th, 262 workstations installed (42 in AAA locations and 220 workstations in Service Centers)
- Installs began in August and forecasted to complete AAA in November and Service Centers in January 2026



Commercial Program 2025 Annual Program Review

- Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) initiated Annual Program Review in August 2025.
- RMV completed checklist and submitted required information in October
- FMCSA indicated there were no new findings






Redesigned Disability Placard

The new placard features several improvements:

- A modern design incorporating the widely accepted universal accessibility logo
- Durable material embedded with security features to deter fraud
- Bilingual instructions in both English and Spanish
- Parking benefits will remain the same and both versions of placard are valid until expiration
- New design and process reduces the processing time by 25%
