Vehicle Registration Email Reminders

Your Massachusetts vehicle registration expires soon.

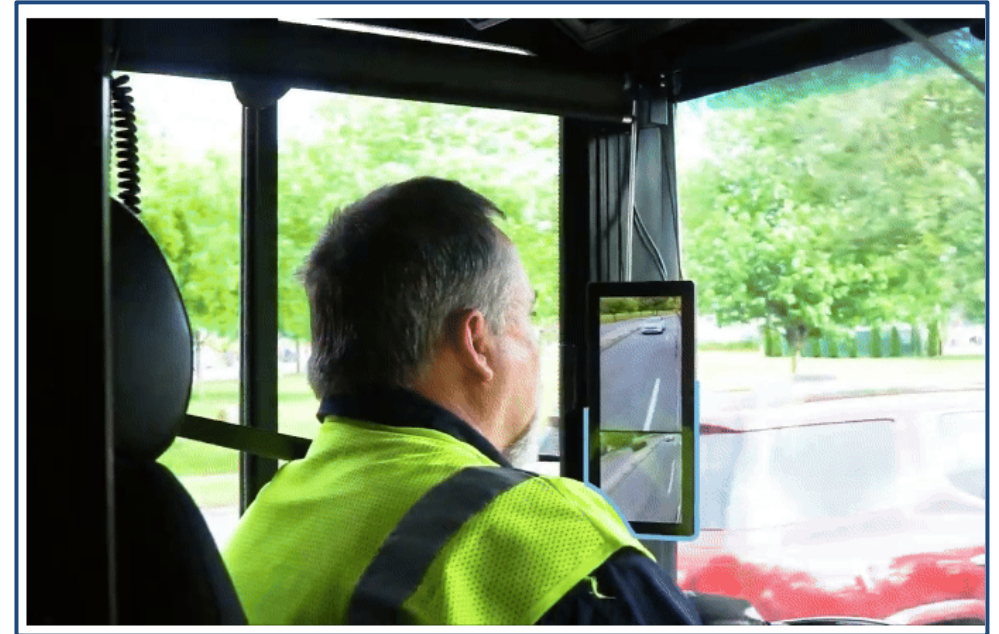
Renew online at [Mass.Gov/myRMV](https://www.mass.gov/myRMV) - it takes only a few minutes!

- The RMV began sending registration email reminders on July 19th to vehicle owners whose registration is expiring within 6 weeks.
- The email will direct customers to go online to renew to allow enough time for the renewed registration and plate decal to be mailed to avoid any interruption to their registration.
- The email will also remind customers to:
 - Pay any outstanding obligations such as parking tickets, toll violations, or excise tax
 - Confirm insurance coverage
 - Verify mailing and residential address

Mirrorless Camera Technology

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- Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration issued a 5-year exemption to 4 companies allowing mirrorless camera systems in place of traditional mirrors
- Technology improves visibility in all weather and lighting conditions, reduces blind spots by providing a wide-angle view, and enhances safety
- Use for intrastate travel requires a waiver to be issued by the RMV. We have been coordinating with Department of Public Utilities, Rail & Transit, MBTA and the companies to evaluate suitability
