#### **New Laws**

#### Temporary License Plates

- M.G.L. c. 90, § 2D, as amended by Chapter 423 of the Acts of 2022
- Provides ability to issue temporary license plates to out of state residents who purchased a vehicle from a MA dealer
- Implementation date of 4/5/23

#### Translation and Accessibility Services

- Item 1599-6090 contained in Section 2A of Chapter 268 of the Acts of 2022
- Provides ability to ensure equitable access to state services, programs, and activities serving limited English proficient individuals
- First phase implementation date of 7/1/23

#### Work and Family Mobility Act (WFMA)

- Chapter 81 of the Acts of 2022
- Provides RMV ability to issue standard driver's license to individuals who can meet identity requirements outlined in the law
- Implementation date of 7/1/23





## **Updated Service – New Languages for Permit Test**

- 7 new foreign languages have been added to list of languages offered for a passenger (Class D) and Motorcycle (Class M) learner's permit exam.
  - Albanian
  - Cape Verdean Creole
  - Hungarian
  - Kiswahili
  - Pashto
  - Turkish
  - Ukrainian
- Permit exams now offered in 36 languages below.


Albanian, Arabic, Armenian, Burmese, Cape Verdean Creole, English, Farsi, French, German, Greek, Gujarati, Haitian Creole, Hindi, Hungarian, Italian, Japanese, Khmer/Cambodian, Kiswahili, Korean, Laotian, Mandarin (Simplified), Mandarin (Traditional), Pashto, Polish, Portuguese, Punjabi, Russian, Serbo-Croatian, Somali, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, Turkish, Ukrainian, Urdu, and Vietnamese.






## Updated Service – Replacement Crash System

- Replacement of the RMV's Crash system. CDS is the system used to process and maintain crash data from across the Commonwealth. The system informs highway safety improvements as well as federal and state policies and regulations to improve public safety.
  - Successfully implemented on 2/21/23.
- Business partners impacted by the improved Crash system are:
  - Local law enforcement & records management vendors
  - MA State Police
  - MassDOT Highway Division safety department
  - Insurance companies
  - Federal partners







## **New Service - IID Services on MyRMV**

- The Ignition Interlock Device (IID) program requires multiple and certain first-time OUI offenders to install an IID in vehicle for 2 years after reinstatement.
  - An IID is a handheld breath-alcohol monitoring device that is connected to a vehicle's ignition.
  - A restriction is placed on applicant's license to indicate this requirement when operating a vehicle - the restriction is not automatically removed at the end of the reinstatement period.
  - Applicant's must schedule an appt with a hearings officer to have the IID removed from their vehicle and the license restriction lifted.
  - Currently, 4,200+ participants have an IID installed
- Eligible customers can now request interlock device services online via Mass.Gov/RMV
- The RMV will review and respond to your request via phone in 3 - 5 business days

## RMV Updates – Vulnerable Road Users Law

Massachusetts law defines 'vulnerable road users' as:

- pedestrians
- roadside workers
- bicyclists
- people riding horses or horse drawn carriages
- people using:
  - wheelchairs
  - mobility devices
  - motorized bicycles
  - motorized scooters
  - o non-motorized scooters
  - skateboards
  - roller skates




When you pass a vulnerable road user, you must leave a safe passing distance of **at least 4 feet** between your vehicle and the road user. If it is safe, you may use all or part of the lane next to you and you may cross the center line if necessary. You must obey the speed limit while passing. The sign above will be posted on roads that do not have designated bike lanes or separated paths.





### REAL ID – 50% adoption

- Implementation date is May 7, 2025
- RMV will be through 5-year cycle in March (implemented REAL ID in March 2018)
