Service Updates

Beginning May 8, a redesigned version of the Red Sox special plate will be available on the RMV website (www.mass.gov/rmv) and can be ordered through RMV Service Centers. The new plate design features a pair of red socks with a blue heart between them.

The previous design Red Sox plates will no longer be issued, but will remain valid.







Service Updates

All school buses are inspected twice per year. The RMV is currently inspecting school buses and as of 5/12, have completed 2/3 of these inspections. There are over 9,000 school buses registered in MA.

All school buses are checked for:

- Body Interior
- Body Exterior
- Chassis
- Special equipment such as wheelchair lift, if applicable







RMV Procurements

RMV Road Test Examination Augmentation

- The Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) is exploring a short-term (1-year) solution to allow for a third-party organization to administer road test exams for Class D driver licenses. Currently all such exams are administered by RMV staff at RMV sites or at driving school locations.
- The RMV anticipates that the combination of existing demand for Class D road test exams and implementation of The Work and Family Mobility Act (H.3012 / S.2061) WFMA will significantly increase overall demand.

3rd party language line solution to Contact Center

 This procurement will expand the RMV's language support for <u>current</u> non-English speaking customers seeking to conduct <u>current</u> transactions or with information needs through <u>3rd party</u> Contact Center agents/staff.





Work and Family Mobility Act (WFMA)

- Chapter 81 of the Acts of 2022 provides RMV ability to issue standard driver's license to those who can meet identity requirements outlined in the law
- Implementation date of 7/1/23
- Regulation changes include
 - The Registry of Motor Vehicles Division ("RMV") will accept public comment on the following regulatory action:
 - Amend 540 CMR 2.06, Requirements for Driver (Operator) Licenses, Learner Permits and Identification Cards.
 - The proposed regulatory action will create an additional option for individuals submitting certain identity documents who were never issued a Social Security Number to meet the requirements to obtain a Massachusetts standard driver's license.
 - Written comments will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on May 19, 2023.





WFMA, cont.

Memorandum of Agreement between MassDOT and National Association of Government Employees (NAGE)

- Increase more staff and salaries for service center and contact customer service representatives and road test examiners
- Ability to leverage third-party assistance for Contact Center, IT helpdesk, Road Test services
- Greater flexibility to manage extended operational hours at Service Centers and vacations during first two weeks of July

Website, Phone Line, Translated Materials


- Dedicated webpage that will be continually updated: Mass.Gov/WFMA

- 3rd party call center dedicated to taking WFMA-related calls and interpreter services will be available to assist costumers who are not proficient in English

Attendees heard about:


- the RMV's highly interactive website for first time drivers and their parents/guardians
