| What practitioners are designated as an LPHA in Massachusetts? | Physicians licensed pursuant to the requirements of M.G.L. c.112 §§ 2, 9, and 9B, which authorizes the person to engage in the practice of medicine (243 CMR 2.00). Registered Nurses licensed pursuant to M.G.L. c.112 §§74-81C (244 CMR 3.00). Psychologists licensed pursuant to M.G.L. c.112 §§118-129B (251 CMR 1.00-4.00). Licensed Independent Clinical Social Workers, Licensed Certified Social Workers and Licensed Social Workers licensed pursuant to M.G.L. c.112 §§130-137 (258 CMR 12.00). Registered Occupational Therapists licensed pursuant to M.G.L. c.112 §23G (259 CMR 3.00). Licensed Rehabilitation Counselors licensed pursuant to M.G.L. c.112 § 165 (262 CMR 4.00). | What does oversight of comprehensive assessment and treatment plan development, quarterly reviews and revision processes by LPHAs require? | The LPHA must oversee the development of the assessment and the updates and ensure that it includes a Clinical Formulation/Interpretive Summary. The LPHA must be involved in the development of the treatment plan, quarterly reviews and revisions in order to ensure that the goals, objectives and interventions reflect the Clinical Formulation/Interpretive Summary and the assessed needs. The comprehensive assessment and treatment plan and quarterly reviews and revisions must be signed by the LPHA. |
