What is happening?

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is conducting a study to assess the potential uses of the MassDOT and MBTA rail parcels located between Route 1A and the Chelsea Creek and evaluate the Route 1A corridor between Bell Circle in Revere and Day Square in East Boston. The study will identify opportunities to improve connections for people walking, biking and taking transit, while also addressing safety issues and the potential impacts of climate change.

Why are we holding this meeting?

At this meeting, MassDOT will update stakeholders and community members on the Study's progress, share results of recent analysis, discuss potential uses of the rail parcels, and listen to community feedback.
