Why was this project initiated?

Existing Deficiencies

- Safety and speed concerns
- Narrow Roadway
- History of crashes along the corridor
- Congestion
- Functionally obsolete bridges
- Limited pedestrian/bicycle accommodations

Project Goals and Objectives

- Improve Safety
- Improve Multi-Modal Mobility
- Replace Functionally Obsolete Bridges







Overview and Highlights

- Replace Route 20 Bridges over the Little River and French River
- Improve bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- Upgrade substandard intersections
- Optimize drainage along the corridor
- Introduce Best Management Practices for stormwater treatment



Reconstruct Route 20 between Richardson Corner in Charlton and Route 12 in Oxford





Final Design Development

Improve Roadway Safety

- Install median barrier/raised median
- Improve roadway alignment and stopping site distance
- Widen roadways to introduce shoulders
- Provide designated emergency pulloff areas





Improve Intersection Operations

- Optimize traffic signal operation
- Add turning lanes
- Accommodate U-turns





Improve Roadway Cross-Section

- Introduce roadway shoulders and dividing median
- Improve Multi-Modal Mobility





Bicycle and Pedestrian Accommodations

- Add shared-use path between Oxbow Road and Route 12 on the north side of Route 20
- Add sidewalk between Route 56 and Route 12 on the south side of Route 20

Replace Functionally Obsolete Bridges



Little River Bridge: replace using conventional construction techniques (2023-2024)



French River Bridge: replace using accelerated construction techniques (2024-2025)





Approach to Final Design End Condition (east end of project)





Temporary Traffic Control

- Maintain Route 20 traffic by using multi-stage construction
- Maintain access to abutters
- Inform public of lane restrictions
- Inform motorists of construction activities by using Real Time Traffic Management system













Construction Overview

Overall project timeline – approximately 4 years

- Daytime work schedule
 - Typical work hours 7:00am to 3:30 pm
 - May vary between 5:00am and 7:00pm
- Occasional night and weekend work
- Maintain emergency services.

Construction

- Major earthwork operations will be within confined work zones
- Minimize construction vehicle turning movements \bullet
- Travel speeds reduced through work zones for safety
- Water spray for dust suppression





Temporary Traffic Control

Local roadway users

- Changeable message signs
- Install construction signage throughout the corridor
- Announcements for detours
- Maintain access to abutters
- Maintain traffic signal operation
- Install cameras at key locations

Regional roadway users

- Install Portable Message Boards informing motorists of travel times
- Portable Message Boards will be installed at decision-making points at the I-84 and I-290 / I-395 interchanges

Upcoming Work Activities

Borings and Test Pits in Progress

- What: Contractor started borings and test pits along Route 20
- Why: to gather data to refine the design of the project
- When: February
- Construction work hours: Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM
- Traffic impacts: intermittent short-term single lane closures of eastbound and westbound Route 20





Vegetation Clearing Begins Soon

- What: Work on erosion controls and vegetation clearing along Route 20
- Why: Necessary to prepare the site for utility relocations
- When: Anticipated from February through April, 2023, weather permitting
- Construction work hours: Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM
- Traffic impacts: intermittent short-term single lane closures of eastbound and westbound Route 20
