



90-Day Look Ahead -Construction Update and Approach

Upcoming Work

Stage 2A, Ongoing – Permanent Expressway closure (February 2023 – July 2025)

- Notification 2 weeks in advance
- Parking is retained through winter on Davol Street
- Regional and local signing added
- Earthwork and bridge demolition activities begin

Stage 2B, What's Next – Parking and Traffic Shifts (Beginning April 2023)

- Parking Removed from Davol Street
- Bridge and wall demolition of old Route 79 continues
- Traffic Shifts on Davol Street Away From Infields
- U-Turn Shifts



Construction Overview

Overall project timeline – approximately 4 years

- Work to occur mostly during the day and weekdays
- Some night work is needed for Bridge Demolition, Culvert installation, and utility work
- Coordination with emergency services to maintain access routes

Construction

- Major earthwork operations will be within confined work zones
- Minimize construction vehicles on active parts of Davol Street

Mitigation: Noise and Dust control

- Noise monitoring systems
- Scheduling of activities based on weather and events
 - Work hours 7am to 3:30 pm
- Water spray for dust suppression



Temporary Traffic Considerations

Local roadway users

- Wayfinding signage for all pedestrian routes
- Detours on nights and/or weekends announced in advance
- Traffic patterns on Davol Street and cross streets will stay similar to existing
- Work to limit speed on Davol Street and improve intersection timings
- All driveways remain open
- No closures of shared use path


Regional

- Signage notifying traffic to use Route 24
- No lanes on Route 79/Davol closed during peak traffic times

Looking South at Veterans Memorial Bridge




- All traffic uses Davol Street.
- Reversing traffic uses
 Corey Street U-turn
- On street parking on Davol minimally impacted.
- Work this stage includes:
 - Bridge Demo
 - Earth moving
 - Utilities

Looking South at Turner Street




- Pedestrian access at southern u-turn maintained
- On street parking on Davol minimally impacted.
- Work this stage includes:
 - Bridge Demo
 - Earth moving
 - Utilities

Looking South at President Ave




- Route 79 Expressway and bridges removed
- On street parking on Davol removed.
- Work this stage includes:
 - construct left half of proposed road and temp paving
