Route 79/Davol Street Corridor, Fall River

What is happening?

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) will hold public informational sessions that will provide plans and information about the preliminary redesign of the Route 79 / Davol Street Corridor in Fall River, between The Cove Restaurant and the Veteran's Memorial Bridge. The sessions will be conducted as an open house in which participants are invited to join at any time during the morning or evening session.

How will this affect you?

The project is intended to increase connectivity, improve safety, and promote economic development. The preliminary design will lower Route 79 and replace it with boulevard with bicycle and pedestrian accommodations. The design also frees up multiple parcels for potential future development. This project seeks to balance transportation needs – meet the needs of local and regional residents – while supporting economic development opportunities.
