

Request for Interpretation Relative to Rule 10

Question #1:

Can the inspector of wires require that no modules be installed until a rough inspection has been completed if grounding is completed after install?

Response: Yes

Question #2

Is the labeling of equipment subject to a rough inspection if these labels are not covered by the building structure?

Question #3

Is the wiring of equipment such as inverters, disconnects and meters, required to be complete for the rough inspection?

Can modules that would cover isolated metal raceways or home runs be installed before a rough inspection is completed?
