### Salt Marsh Nature Trek

Explore this natural habitat on a moderately-paced three-mile walk across a relatively flat trail at Rumney Marsh Reservation. You may spot wildlife such as coyote, raptors, and see groupings of tree species like oak and pine. Bring binoculars for the best views, some loaner binoculars available thanks to the Friends of Belle Isle Marsh. Dress appropriately for the weather, wear sturdy footwear and micro spikes as needed based on trail conditions. If the trail is deemed difficult or unsafe, the program will be cancelled.
