Salt Marsh Nature Trek

Explore this natural habitat on a moderately-paced three-mile walk across a relatively flat trail at Rumney Marsh Reservation. You may spot wildlife such as coyote, and raptors, and see groupings of tree species like oak and pine. Bring binoculars for the best views, but some loaner binoculars are available thanks to the Friends of Belle Isle Marsh.
