Salt Marsh Nature Trek

Explore this natural habitat on a moderately-paced three-mile walk across relatively flat, easy trails at Rumney Marsh Reservation. You may spot wildlife such as coyote, raptors, snow buntings, horned larks, and groupings of tree species like oak and pine.
