### The Seal Sensation Station

Stop by this pop-up station for a few minutes or longer, for an up-close look at sea ducks and gulls in action!

**Ages:** For adults & children 5+ accompanied by an adult.

Note that children under age 5 are typically not yet developmentally ready to use binoculars or scopes, but they are welcome to enjoy the table displays!

**Where:** DCR's Salisbury Beach Reservation. You can find the seal viewing station along the Merrimack River, directly across from the playground. After parking in Lot 1, simply head right along the river path or roadway for a short distance. Look for the setup featuring spotting scopes and educational table displays.
