DECISION

KALLONY INC. D/B/A STRIPER'S GRILLE
175 BRIDGE ROAD
SALISBURY, MA 01952
LICENSE#: 106600004

Kallony Inc. d/b/a Striper's Grille (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 13, 2016, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Doyle's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report dated July 20, 2016;
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
3. ABCC 2016 Compliance Check Guidelines; and
4. Photo of Underage Operative.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

1. On Wednesday, July 20, 2016, at approximately 6:10 p.m., Investigators Bailey and Doyle ("Investigators") investigated the business operation of Kallony Inc. d/b/a Striper's Grille.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, was in possession of an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. . As the Licensee has been in business more than 10 years and has had no previous violation, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
