


Project Scope

- Reconstruction of 2.5 miles of Lafayette Road (Route 1) –
 from Route 1A (Beach Road) in Salisbury Square and extends northerly to the
 New Hampshire State Line.
 - Pavement Improvements Following Town Utility Upgrades
 - Inclusion of Complete Streets Elements
 - Roundabout Design at Toll Road and Route 286
 - ADA Accessibility
 - Bicycle and Pedestrian Accommodations
 - Bridge Alternatives at Small Pox Creek

- Minimize Right-of-Way Impacts
















Forest Road - Existing Intersection






Forest Road - Proposed Intersection
