DECISION.

FORESTDALE MOBIL, INC. DBA FORESTDALE MOBILE SANDWICH, MA 02644

LICENSE#: 107400027 HEARD: 10/02/2012

Forestdale Mobil, Inc. dba Forestdale Mobile (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 2, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 16, 2012.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, May 16, 2012 at approximately 6:00 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Binienda conducted an investigation of the business operation of Forestdale Mobil, Inc. dba Forestdale Mobile.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a Bud Light beer for six dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$6.99). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
