Dear Ms. Jones, Mr. Messina and Mr. Perry:

I am writing on behalf of S&C Corp (“S&C” or “the Company”). The Company operates a last mile delivery company operating primarily at 1025 Elm Street in Bridgewater, Massachusetts (the “Station”). We regret to inform you that no later than July 15, 2025, the Company will end its operations at the Station and will lay off approximately 50 employees who work out of the Station. While the Company does not believe this layoff is covered by the Massachusetts Plant Closing Law, Mass. G.L. c. 151A, § 71B(a) or the Worker Adjustment and Retaining (“WARN”) Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 *et seq.*, S&C wishes to provide you with notice of such closing so you are aware of it, and so the appropriate state and local agencies may provide impacted employees with any available assistance. In providing such notice, the Company makes no admission that such laws apply to these circumstances.


Notification to employees will be conducted beginning on June 15, 2025, and will be completed that same day. All employment losses at the Station are expected to be permanent and there will be no bumping rights.
