

Safe Routes to School Trivia Review Game: User Guide

The Massachusetts Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program works to increase safe biking and walking among elementary and middle school students by using a collaborative, community-focused approach that bridges the gap between health and transportation. This trivia review game is fun and engaging approach to learning both safe bike and pedestrian habits.

- ✓ Once the PowerPoint has finished downloading/opening, make sure to go into Slide Show mode (“Slide Show-> from Beginning) so the first slide covers the whole screen. Presenter Mode is best because the moderator of the game can see the notes for certain questions and answers (some require a follow-up explanation). We recommend that the moderator scrolls through the questions and answers ahead of time to see what types of questions will be asked and the expected answers.
- ✓ There is no score keeping incorporated into this game. It is up to the moderator to decide how to split students into teams and keep score (not required). The main objective is to educate students on walking, biking, and rolling safely.
- ✓ To get to the question selection panel, simply hit the space bar or right arrow on the keyboard like a regular PowerPoint presentation.
- ✓ When a number is selected, it will hyperlink to the associated question. After the student(s) answer(s), click on the answer button in the lower right-hand corner of the screen. This will take you to the answer screen. Keep in mind there might be some follow-up points in the “notes” section. To go back to the home screen, simply click the “Home” button in the lower right-hand corner of the screen.
- ✓ Once the home screen is displayed, any questions that were clicked on will have disappeared to help keep track of what questions were asked. This will automatically reset once out of Slide Show/Presenter Mode.
- ✓ When all the questions have been answered, click the bike icon in the lower right-hand corner of the screen. This will be the final/bonus question for the students.
- ✓ Please remember that this is a fun and interactive event, so enjoy! We invite you to have discussions with your students throughout the game. If you have any questions, please reach out to the Safe Routes to School Team!
