

Seabrook Nuclear Power Station Preparedness Survey

About the survey:

The operators of the Seabrook Nuclear Power Station in New Hampshire have created an online survey to assist in updating emergency plans that would be used in the unlikely event of an incident at the plant. (The survey is available at the link above.) The information gathered will be shared with local and state emergency management officials to assist with preparedness planning.

The short survey asks Massachusetts residents in the plant's 10-mile Emergency Planning Zone questions about evacuation, how they would leave if asked to do so by public safety officials, and the estimated time needed to evacuate. The anonymous survey also asks questions about basic demographics and emergency alert preferences.
