## NOTICE TO SEA URCHIN FISHERMEN

The Marine Fisheries Commission approved a control date on February 3, 1994 for the sea urchin dredge fishery, and a second control date of September 11, 1995 for the sea urchin dive fishery. The "control date" may be used in the future to limit entry into the urchin dredge and dive fisheries. Any fisherman who did not hold a regulated sea urchin permit endorsed for dredging by February 3, 1994 may be ineligible to participate in this fishery in the future. Further, any fisherman who did not hold a regulated sea urchin permit endorsed for diving by September 11, 1995 may be ineligible to participate in this fishery in the future. Notice will be sent if DMF and MFC feel a limited entry system for either of these urchin fisheries is warranted.

- A copy of a valid drivers license or voter registration card
- And fee (\$30 for Massachusetts residents and \$60 for non-residents), made payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
