SECRETARY GALVIN APPOINTS JUSTICE R. MARC KANTROWITZ TO THE STATE ETHICS COMMISSION

Secretary of the Commonwealth William F. Galvin announced today that he is appointing retired Appeals Court Justice R. Marc Kantrowitz to fill a five year term on the State Ethics Commission.

"I am pleased to appoint Justice Kantrowitz to the Ethics Commission," Galvin said. "I believe that with the experience he brings to the position, he will make for an excellent addition to the Commission."

Judge Kantrowitz was nominated by Governor Paul Cellucci to the Appeals Court in 2001 and previously served as an associate justice of the Juvenile Court. Kantrowitz also served as an Assistant District Attorney in Suffolk County for six years. He retired from the Appeals Court in 2015.

The State Ethics Commission administers laws relating to conflicts of interest and financial disclosure. The Commission consists of five members, with one appointed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth, one by the Attorney General, and three by the Governor.
